The qualified counselor is a positive role model of Korean heritage who can supervise and build positive relationships with campers. We accept Day Camp Counselors as young as the mid-teens. All counselors will need to attend a training session from 12:00-4:00 on Sunday, July 1st. There can be no exceptions. Counselors are responsible for rides to and from camp during the week of July 2-6th.

Group Assignments & Expectations:

Day camper groups range from Kindergarten – 6th grade. Counselors for young campers – be prepared to help campers prepare for swimming, carrying backpacks, counting money at the store and working through separation from parents. All counselors – be prepared to participate in sessions and opening/closing ceremonies. Counselors are also expected to help with Cho-whey.
